

# Asthma 411 Spring Challenge Grant: Ready, Set, Launch 2022-2023!

Deadline for Submission: April 30, 2022

**Project Overview:** Up to \$2,000.00 will be awarded to individual schools or school districts to pilot an intervention to strengthen school asthma services.

### **Proposal Submission:**

- Please provide all information listed on the next page
- Please include a letter of support from your school administrator on official letterhead
- Email your proposal and letter of support to Asthma411.unthsc.edu

#### Timeline:

- March 22st: Announcement
- April 30st: Deadline for submission
- May 15<sup>th</sup>: Winners announced
- May 30<sup>th</sup> to August 2022: Preparation to launch
- August through December: Project implementation
- January 9, 2023: Reports submitted

Support: Asthma 411 staff will provide support during project implementation and reporting.

### **Criteria for Selection:** Proposals should:

- Align with best practice recommendations outlined in National School -based Asthma Management. Program (SAMPRO) or ALA's Asthma Friendly School Initiative (AFSI).
- Define the specific objectives and actions of the project.
- Be achievable to pilot within the proposal the timeframe.
- Have a measurable outcome to determine if your objective has been met, that will be included in the final report.
- Include all items specified on page two.

**Projects Categories:** There are four project categories with examples listed below.

- 1. <u>Maximizing School Health Services</u>
  - Assess students reported to have asthma and identify those who may be at highest risk. (ex. Date of
    most recent Primary Care or Asthma Specialist visit, hospitalization or ED visits within the past year,
    course of oral steroids in the past year.
  - Assess students with indications of poor or deteriorating control using the Asthma Control Test. (use
    of standing delegation orders, using quick-relief medication more than 2X per week, elevated
    absences.

### 2. Asthma Education

- Implement programs for students, families, coaches, teachers, or other school staff
- 3. Healthy School Environments
  - Identify and address potential environmental triggers using nationally recommended tools, adapted for you school.
- 4. <u>Links to Resources</u> Supported health care referrals for children with indications of poor or deteriorating control
